LET IT SNOW... General Snow Removal Information

Winter weather is upon us and we want to take this time to remind you about our snow removal policy. The City will provide snow and ice removal, keeping in mind safety, budget, personnel and environmental concerns.

The Public Works Department will decide when to begin snow or ice control operations. The criteria for that decision are:

- A. Snow accumulation of 2 inches or more;
- B. Drifting of snow that causes problems for travel;
- C. Icy conditions which seriously affect travel; and
- D. Time of snowfall in relationship to heavy use of streets.

The City will use sand, salt and other chemicals when there are hazardous ice or slippery conditions. The City does take into consideration the effect of such chemicals on the environment and will limit its use for that reason.

Main "hill" streets and arterial routes will be plowed first. These are high volume routes, which connect major sections of the City and provide access for emergency fire, police and medical services. Drive areas adjacent to emergency service buildings shall also be plowed at this time in order to allow passage for emergency vehicles.

Residents are responsible for shoveling their sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall has ceased. We ask for your compliance to help keep your family and neighbors safe. Failure to comply can result in a \$125 fee if the City is required to shovel your sidewalk. Free salt & sand is available to our residents only (no contractors) at 1213 Hazel Street.

Pet Licensing

Don't forget to license your pet! The City of Le Sueur requires a license for all cats or dogs over 4 months of age. Cats & Dogs must be registered annually, on or before the first day of January. It's very important that dogs and cats are licensed, and that the tag is placed on the animal. If your dog or cat is missing and is picked up without a tag, the animal could be turned over to Animal Control and may end up at their kennel in Jordan, MN. If the tag is on your dog or cat, a Police Officer or Animal Control staff can check the information with our records system and your pet can be returned to you promptly.

To license your pet, please visit the Le Sueur Police Department at 205 South 2nd Street. The Le Sueur Police Department hours are Monday – Friday; 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. There is a \$5.00 charge for each pet license issued. Owners must provide proof of vaccination for each pet at the time of registration. Thank you for your compliance!

WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS

After a Snow Emergency is Declared:

Any vehicle on any public street must be moved within 24 hours after a snow emergency is declared so that streets may be plowed. No vehicles may be parked between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. on these streets:

- * On Main St. between Cathcart St. & Bridge St., and between Ferry St. & Smith St.
- * On Second St. between Swan St. & Ferry St.
- * On Ferry St. between Third St. & the Easterly right of way of railroad tracks
- * On Bridge St. between Fifth St. & the Easterly right of way of railroad tracks
- * On Swan St. between Second St. & Main St.

2016 Budget Overview

The City Council will hear public comment when they consider the final citywide tax levy for 2016 at their meeting on December 14th at 6:30pm in the City Hall Council Chambers. The Council set the preliminary levy in September with a 3% increase. If the council sets the levy at the proposed 3% increase, approximately \$242,000 in funds could be put toward costs associated with street maintenance projects. This includes crack filling, sealcoating, mill and overlay, total reconstruction.
