What you Need to Know About 2016 Elections

Are you a registered voter? Do you want to make a positive change in your community? This year, will we have three council member terms expiring in Ward 2; one council member term expiring in Ward 1 and the Mayor's term expiring as well.

The Le Sueur City Council exercises the legislative power of the City of Le Sueur and determines all matters of policy. For our Council to effectively serve the City of Le Sueur, we need willing citizens to serve in this capacity. Candidacy for elective municipal offices will open at 9:00am on Tuesday, August 2nd and runs through 5:00pm on Tuesday, August 16th. Elections will be held on Tuesday, November 8th.

Filing for City Council candidacy is easy!

1. Submit a petition to City Hall signed by 25 eligible voters
2. Pay a \$2.00 registration fee

The mayor is the presiding officer of the council and is elected to be the head of government for a city or town.

At the June 27, 2016 regular city council meeting, council members voted to begin the process of eliminating the ward system in Le Sueur. If passed, Le Sueur's voting system for council vacancies would be "at large" meaning individuals may cast votes for as many candidates as there are council members seats up for election, no longer separated by Ward.
