

## WHO CAN BRING THEIR MATERIALS TO THE SITE?

Residents who live in the City limits of Le Sueur. All residents should be prepared to show their driver's license or an alternate form of identification if needed. No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses or those residing outside of the City limits will be accepted.

### ACCEPTABLE ITEMS AND PREPARATION GUIDELINES:

- General non-hazardous household waste "junk"
- Furniture items
  - Couches/chairs/tables/mattresses/box springs/etc.
- Small amounts of re-modeling materials
  - Siding/dried-out paint cans/drywall/carpet/etc.
- Smaller items **MUST BE** boxed, bagged or contained
- No loads of loose shingles or tires will be accepted
