
Snowmobiling Information & Map

For snowmobiling within City limits, please stick to the designated trail (see map, below). Trail hours

are 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m. The speed limit is 15 MPH.



Snow Accumulation Reminders

As stated in City of Le Sueur Ordinances, Section 23-4 “The owner and occupants of lots shall keep the sidewalks in front of or adjacent to their respective lots free and clear from snow, ice and other obstructions; and snow and ice shall be removed therefrom within twenty-four (24) hours after the snow stops falling”. Authority to enforce this ordinance is given to the Common Council under M.S.A. 411.40, subdivision (2).

If the matter is not taken care of within twenty-four (24) hours of notification by letter, the City will be forced to abate the problem and the cost of such work will become a debt owed by you to the City of Le Sueur, with the minimum charge being one hundred twenty five dollars (\$125.00). If not paid, it will be placed on a special assessment against your property and filed with the County Auditor and collected with your property Taxes

FREE sand and salt is available to city residents at the City Garage located at 1213 Hazel Street. To keep your home safe, please keep fire hydrants in front of your property free and clear of snow and ice as well.

We would also like to take this time to remind you about moving your vehicles after a snowfall. This enables our plow trucks to properly clean the street in front of your home. It is important to keep our streets in good, clean condition for our emergency vehicles as well. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter.

Youth Soccer Registration - Le Sueur Community Center

Thursday, January 16th 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Soccer registration night will be Thursday, January 16th from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. (you may register anytime before this deadline at the Community Center). Your Childs’ playing level will be determined by his/her age as of August 1, 2014. Players will need to provide a small photo for their soccer club registration card, as well as a copy of their birth certificate for proof of age. You may call ahead (507-665-3325) to see if we have your child’s birth certificate on file (if they have participated in the past). This is a regulation within the Minnesota Youth Soccer Association, so there will be no exceptions to this rule. Soccer will start in spring. Teams and coaches will be assigned after registration and you will be notified of start dates and times.
