## International Property Maintenance Code Information from Building Inspector, Dan Murphy

Spring is here! With Spring comes warmer temperatures and of course many household projects. We would like to take this time to educate you on the importance of maintaining your home, property, and buildings.

The International Property Maintenance Code (IPMC) was adopted as an amendment to Ordinance No. 486, Chapter 6, Article II in October of 2005. Its purpose is to provide minimum standards to safeguard life or limb, property and public welfare by regulating and controlling the use and occupancy, location and maintenance of all existing residential and non-residential structures and all existing premises within the City of Le Sueur. In short, this code requires property owners to maintain their property and/or buildings in the City of Le Sueur. Maintenance includes, but is not limited to: repairing broken windows and siding, painting, checking smoke detectors, repairing driveways, maintaining retaining walls and surface drainage, etc. A copy of the IPMC is on file at City Hall (203 South 2<sup>nd</sup> Street) for public review. ### Election Judge and City Council Openings

Serving as an Election Judge is a great way to learn more about the election process while serving your community! To serve as an election judge you must: be a US Citizen, live within the City limits, not have your voting rights revoked, be able to read, write, and speak English, and attend a 2-hour training session. Election Judge Training has been scheduled for:

**Wednesday, July 23, 2014 at 10:00 a.m., 2:00 p.m., and 6:30 p.m.**

Training will take place at the American Legion in Le Center (97 South Park Avenue). If you have interest in becoming an election judge, please call City Clerk, Monica Muchow at (507) 665-6401, Ext. 202.

If appointed, you will be scheduled to serve at the State Primary Election on August 12, 2014, and State General Election on November 4, 2014. By law, your employer must give you paid time off to serve as an Election Judge (to qualify, you must provide your employer with at least 20 days written notice).

**Have you ever considered running for City Council? We will have the following vacancies for City Council positions: Two - Ward 1 Council Members, and One - Ward 2 Council Member. Effective government needs thoughtful, dedicated citizens to make it work. To file: pick up a "Nomination Petition" form at City Hall, and get the signatures of 25 registered voters in Le Sueur city limits, and file an Affidavit of Candidacy with the City Clerk during the filing period (July 29<sup>th</sup> - August 12<sup>th</sup>) and submit a \$2.00 filing fee.**
