Let it Snow.... General Snow Removal Info.

With winter right around the corner, we want to take this time to remind you about our snow removal policy. The City of Le Sueur believes that it is in the best interest of the residents, for the City to assume basic responsibility for control of snow and ice on City streets. Reasonable ice and snow control is necessary for routine travel and emergency services. The City will provide such control in a safe and cost effective manner, keeping in mind safety, budget, personnel, and environmental concerns. The City will use City employees, equipment and/or private contractors to provide this service.

The Public Works Director or his designee will decide when to begin snow or ice control operations. The criteria for that decision are:

- A. Snow accumulation of 2 inches or more;
- B. Drifting of snow that causes problems for travel;
- C. Icy conditions which seriously affect travel; and
- D. Time of snowfall in relationship to heavy use of streets.

The City will use sand, salt, and other chemicals when there are hazardous ice or slippery conditions. The City is concerned about the effect of such chemicals on the environment and will limit its use for that reason.

The City has classified City streets based on the street function, traffic volume, and importance to the welfare of the community. Main "hill" streets and arterial routes will be plowed first. These are high volume routes, which connect major sections of the City and provide access for emergency fire, police, and medical services. Drive areas adjacent to emergency service buildings (Police, Fire, Ambulance, and Hospital) shall also be plowed at this time in order to allow emergency vehicles egress and ingress to these facilities.

Residents are responsible for shoveling their sidewalks. Free salt & sand is available to our residents only (no contractors) at 1213 Hazel St.

Pet Licensing

Don't forget to license your pet! The City of Le Sueur requires a license for all cats or dogs over 4 months of age. Cats & Dogs must be registered annually, on or before the first day of January. It's very important that dogs and cats are licensed, and that the tag is placed on the animal. If your dog or cat is missing and is picked up without a tag, the animal could be turned over to Animal Control and may end up at their kennel in Jordan, MN. If the tag is on your dog or cat, a Police Officer or Animal Control staff can check the information with our records system and your pet can be returned to you promptly.

To license your pet, please visit the Le Sueur Police Department at 205 South 2nd Street. The Police Department hours are Monday – Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. at the Le Sueur Police Department, 205 South Second Street. There is a \$5.00 charge for each pet license issued. Owners must provide proof of vaccination for each pet at the time of registration.

WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS – REMINDER

After a Snow Emergency is Declared:

Any vehicle on any public street must be moved within 24 hours after a snow emergency is declared so that streets may be plowed. No vehicles may be parked between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. on these streets:

- * On Main St. between Cathcart St. & Bridge St., and between Ferry St. & Smith St.
- * On Second St. between Swan St. & Ferry St.
- * On Ferry St. between Third St. & the Easterly right of way of railroad tracks
- * On Bridge St. between Fifth St. & the Easterly right of way of railroad tracks
- * On Swan St. between Second St. & Main St.
