### Winter Parking Regulations - Reminder

#### After a Snow Emergency is Declared:

- \* Any vehicle on any public street must be moved within 24 hours after a snow emergency is declared so that streets may be plowed
- \* No vehicles may be parked between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 am on these streets:
  - \* On Main St. between Cathcart St. & Bridge St., and between Ferry St. & Smith St.
  - \* On Second St. between Swan St. & Ferry St.
  - \* On Ferry St. between Third St. & the Easterly right of way of railroad tracks
  - \* On Bridge St. between Fifth St. & the Easterly right of way of railroad tracks
  - \* On Swan St. between Second St. & Main St.
