Recreational Fires

It's campfire season! The City of Le Sueur Fire Dept. would like to remind you to use caution with recreational fires, and follow our guidelines.

A recreational fire is the burning of materials (other than rubbish) for pleasure, religious, ceremonial, cooking, or similar purposes where the fuel being burned is contained in an incinerator, outdoor fireplace, barbecue grill, or barbecue pit and with a total fuel area of **3 feet or less in diameter and 2 feet or less in height.**

- Recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible materials unless contained in an approved barbecue pit constructed of concrete or other approved noncombustible material.
- Buckets, shovels, garden hoses or a fire extinguisher with a minimum 4-A rating shall be readily available for use at recreational fires.
- Recreational fires shall be constantly attended by a person knowledgeable in the use of fire extinguishing equipment. An attendant shall supervise a recreational fire until such fire has been extinguished.
- Any officer of the Le Sueur Fire Dept., Minnesota DNR, Le Sueur Police Dept., or Le Sueur Sheriff Dept. is authorized to require that recreational fires be immediately discontinued if such fires are determined to constitute a hazardous or nuisance condition.
- Recreational fires will not be allowed if a total burning ban is in effect.
- Maximum wind speed including gusts must not exceed 10 MPH.
- The prevailing winds must be away from occupied structures.
