Parking/Zoning Reminders from Dan Murphy

PARKING RESTRICTION REMINDER:

We have been mailing a lot of notices out, due to residents parking on their grass. The approved surfaces for parking areas are addressed, below. Basically, off-street parking must be surfaced with concrete, asphalt or paving stone.

Sec. 27-67. Design and Maintenance of Off-Street Parking Areas

F. Off-street parking areas shall be improved with a concrete, bituminous paving stone or equally durable and dustless surface. Such areas shall be so graded and drained as to dispose of all surface water accumulation within the area. These requirements shall also apply to open sales lots for cars, trucks, and other equipment.

As defined by the zoning ordinance: Parking Space. A surfaced and permanently maintained area on privately owned property either within or outside of a building of sufficient size to store one (1) standard automobile.
