## RECREATIONAL FIRES

Campfire season is upon us! To ensure your safety, the Le Sueur Fire Dept. would like to take this opportunity to remind you about the guidelines for recreational fires in our City. A recreational fire is the burning of materials (other than rubbish) for pleasure, religious, ceremonial, cooking or similar purposes where the fuel being burned is not contained in an incinerator, outdoor fireplace, barbecue grill or barbecue pit. These fires must have a total fuel area of **3** feet or less in diameter and **2** feet or less in height.
