Snowmobiling Information & Map



Many of our residents take part in this sport, so we would like to remind you of our snowmobile regulations. For snowmobiling within City limits, please stick to the designated trail (see map, below). Trail hours

are 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 p.m.; with a posted speed limit of 15 MPH.

LE SUEUR COUNTY CITIZEN ALERT SYSTEM



Le Sueur County recently launched a new Citizen Alert System. This mass notification service allows them to alert subscribers about emergencies and other important community news via phone, text and email. Residents “opt-in” by entering contact information and then subscribe to notifications based on location. You can choose to receive notifications about events that may affect your home, workplace, schools and more. This system will be used to notify you about critical information quickly for a variety of situations such as; severe weather, flooding, gas leaks, unexpected road closures, missing persons, police activity and evacuations of buildings or neighborhoods. When Le Sueur County issues a notification in regard to a potential safety hazard or concern, you will receive a message via the communication methods to you have registered.

Youth Soccer Registration - Le Sueur Community Center

Thursday, January 15th 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Soccer registration night will be Thursday, January 15th from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. (you may register anytime before this deadline at the Community Center). Your Childs' playing level will be determined by his/her age as of August 1, 2015. Players will need to provide a small photo for their soccer club registration card, as well as a copy of their birth certificate for proof of age. You may call ahead (507-665-3325) to see if we have your child's birth certificate on file (if they have participated in the past). This is a regulation within the Minnesota Youth Soccer Association, so there will be no exceptions to this rule. Soccer will start in spring. Teams and coaches will be assigned after registration and you will be notified of start dates and times.
