Effective January 1, 2018, utility service rates and service charges will increase. These changes were reviewed by the Council Personnel & Budget Committee and presented and approved by City Council on December 11, 2017.

These kinds of increases ensure proper maintenance to our infrastructure and provide uninterrupted service to our residents.

How much of an increase will I see on my bill?

The average household consuming 450 kWh of electricity and 5,000 gallons of water can expect to see an increase of approximately \$21.00.
