LET'S TALK SOME TRASH! [AND RECYCLING TOO]

Waste Management has requested we pass along a few garbage and recycling tips to you. Here's the three most frequently talked about items:

1] YARD WASTE: Due to the risk of fire, please do not put yard waste in your garbage or recycle containers. Waste Management cannot collect or dispose of it. For your convenience, yard waste may be dropped off at the City compost site.

2] CONTAINERS/BINS: Waste Manage can and will repair or replace broken lids, wheels or containers. If your garbage or recycle containers are broken, please contact Kaari Smith at City Hall at (507) 665-6401 or ksmith@cityoflesueur.com. Information we'll need from you: name, address, and description of repair or replacement.

3] BAG YOUR GARBAGE: Please help keep our City clean by bagging your garbage. This reduces the amount of items that can spill over when garbage is collected.
