The main focus of this meeting was to update residents on the plan to re-open Le Sueur's Main Street. Re-opening Main Street was one of the main priorities outlined in the Downtown Master Plan. City staff has been working with MnDOT and Le Sueur County to find ways to make this happen, and staff will continue to work with our partners in finding a viable solution. Halloween Safety Tips from the Le Sueur Police Department

- Cross the street at corners and use crosswalks.
- Look left, right and left again when crossing and keep looking as you cross.
- Put electronic devices down and keep heads up and walk, don't run, across the street.
- Trick-or-Treat with an adult. Children under 12 should have supervision. If kids are mature enough to be without supervision, they should stick to familiar areas that are well lit and trick-or-treat in groups.
- Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers and, if possible, choose light colors.
