Protect Your Valuables

We tend to see a rise in vehicle break-ins during the summer. You can help prevent "opportunity crimes" by removing any valuables from your vehicle and always locking your doors, even if your vehicle is parked in your driveway. Please remember to report any suspicious activity to the LSPD at (507) 665-2041 or 911 for an emergency.

Please Do Not Place Free or Junk Items in Boulevards

Although it is often with well-intention, placing free/junk items in the street is unsightly and can be considered a public nuisance. Please properly dispose of these items or list them on a local sale site. As a reminder, fall clean-up day will be coming up in September, and most items can be disposed of for free at that time. Thank you for your assistance in keeping Le Sueur looking nice!

WATER CONSERVATION

With more than 75 percent of Minnesota experiencing severe drought and some areas experiencing extreme drought, we all need to pitch in and reduce our water consumption. The City of Le Sueur is asking all customers to join the effort by reducing your water use during this time.

One of the easiest ways to do this is by altering lawn-watering habits. Most yards only need approximately 1" of water per week to stay healthy. Water lawns just once a week early in the morning or evening to maximize absorption.

Here are some other easy changes you can make:

- Take shorter showers
- Turn the faucet off while brushing your teeth
- Load dishes in the dishwasher without rinsing them
- Run the dishwasher only when full
- Only wash full loads of laundry
- Check for toilet or plumbing leaks
