Proper Disposal of Yard Debris

We are glad to see some rain here in Le Sueur! We'd like to remind property owners to properly dispose of yard debris (Ordinance 96.02).

Yard debris can clog stormwater drainage systems (see photo) and adversely affect our rivers, lakes, and streams. Please be sure to keep grass clippings in your yard or properly dispose of them at the City's compost site (located off of Boright Street).

WHO CAN BRING ITEMS?

Residents who live in Le Sueur City limits. Proof of residency required. No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses, or those residing outside of the City limits will be accepted.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- General non-hazardous household waste “junk”
- Furniture
 - Couches/chairs/tables/mattresses/box springs/etc.
- Small amounts of remodeling materials
 - Siding/dried-out paint cans/drywall/carpet/etc.

PREPARATION GUIDELINES:

- All items **must be boxed, bagged, or contained** and/or easily transferable into garbage receptacles

WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

- Batteries
- Chemical/cleaning products
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Industrial waste
- Liquid waste
- Paints, thinners, removers
- Oils, oil rags
- Shingles
- Tires
- Yard waste

A fee will be charged for some electronics and appliances.
