2017 Fall Tree Sale Descriptions

Prairie Crab Apple: Green to maroon leaves in fall. Rich, red blooms in spring. 20'H by 20'W at maturity.

Accolade Elm: Glossy, dark green leaves turning golden yellow in fall. Fast growing, and disease resistant to Dutch Elm. 70'H by 50'W at maturity.

New Horizon Elm: Compact, upright, rapid-growing hybrid. 40'H by 25'W at maturity.

Autumn Blaze Maple: Striking orange-red to red fall colors. Fast growing hybrids of red and silver maple. 60' H by 40' W at maturity.

Fall Fiesta Maple: Showy orange color in fall. Robust, dark green leaves in summer. Well-branched structure. 50'H by 35'W at maturity.

Sienna Maple: Green foliage throughout the season. Showy red flowers along branches in early spring. Outstanding red leaf in the fall. 50'H by 30'W at maturity.

Sugar Maple: Yellow-orange fall color. Forms an upright oval at maturity. 75' H by 50' W at maturity.

Skyline Locust: Pyramidal form, strong sturdy trunk and shapely crown. 50'H by 35'W at maturity.

Red Oak: Glossy dark green foliage turning reddish-brown to red-orange in the fall. Fast growing with very hard wood and easy to transplant. Great for use as a street or landscape tree. 50'H by 40'W at maturity.

Swamp/White Oak: Glossy, green leaves turning mahogany-brown in the fall. The easiest oak to transplant due to its fibrous root system. Swamp oak has a rounded crown and interesting bark and it grows well on both wet and upland soils. 60'H by 40'W at maturity.

Hackberry: Rapid growth rate, corky rough bark and a round spreading shape. 75'H by 50'W' at maturity.

Little Leaf Linden: Heart-shaped, glossy dark green leaves. Exceptional shade tree. Small, fragrant, yellowish flowers appear in early summer. Pyramidal shape 55'H by 40'W at maturity.

American Sentry Linden: Large leaves. Requires a larger area as it is broad. 60'H by 30'W at maturity.
