PURPOSE

To provide the RPAC Committee information to have a continued discussion regarding Le Sueur Community Center services.

SUMMARY

City council approved the community center to partner with Connecting Kids to offer scholarships to those families in need of assistance for recreational programs. Families will now be able to apply for this scholarship for all recreational programs offered by the community center. This agreement will start April 1, 2023, and go through June of 2025.

Arena – the regular season is ending. March 16 is the last day and ice will come out. The association help their annual mite jamboree which brough in 260 players from 10 associations. It was a very busy day here at the community center.

Golf Simulator - City staff installed a ramp with turf in the golf simulator room. Staff is also building tables and will add more seating as well as a mini fridge to the room.

Fitness Center - Bob Liebhard has been working on the fitness equipment with routine maintenance to the treadmills. So if you see a treadmill missing from the area it is getting its maintenance and will be rotated back into place.

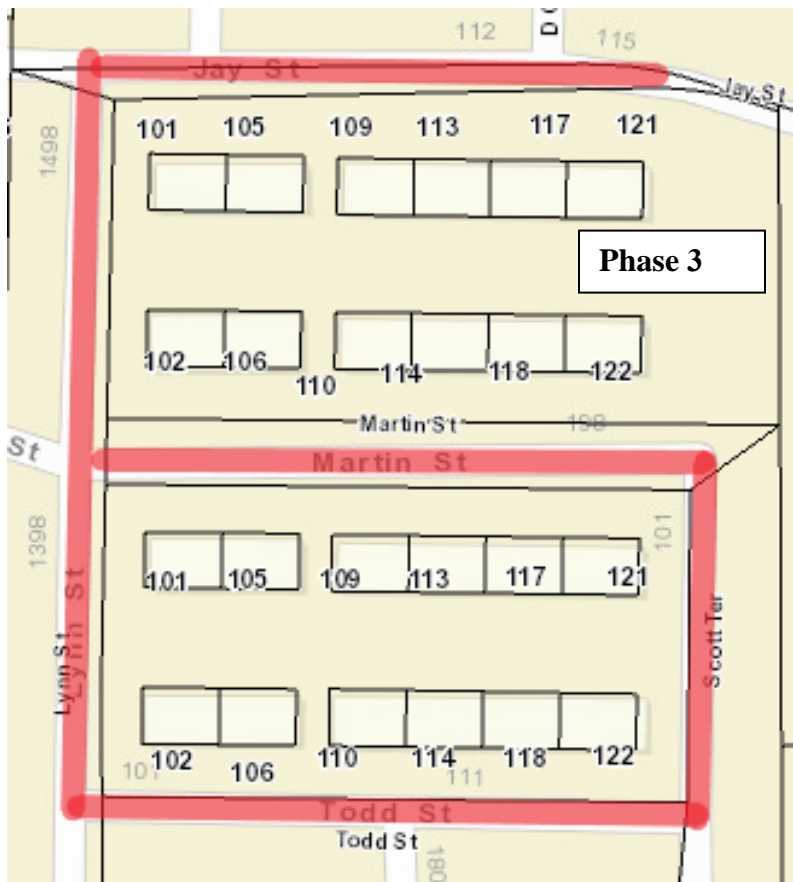
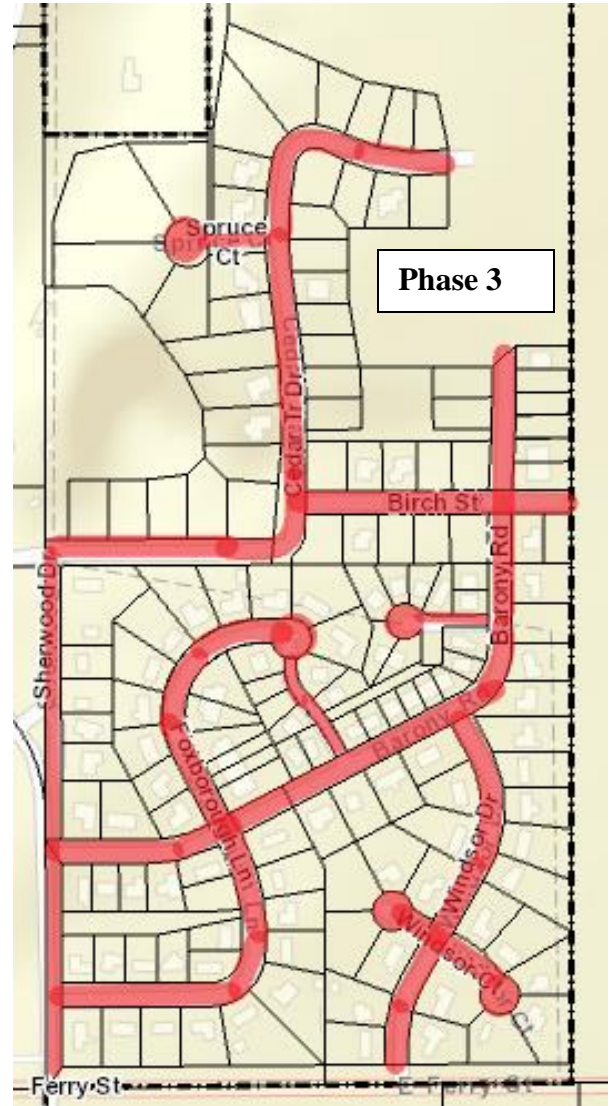
March Cardio challenge is starting March 1st. The cities wellness committee is encouraging all city staff to take part in this challenge as part of the wellness program.
