Chair Broeder called the meeting to order at 6:16 pm.

A motion by King, seconded by Jones to approve the minutes from the previous meeting of July 20, 2020. Voting in favor: Broeder, King, Jones, Vortherms, and Wells. Voting against: None. Motion carried.

The Charter Commission reviewed the proposed Section 6.04 Update.

A motion by Broeder, seconded by King add language citing Minnesota State Statue related to bidding and conflicts of interest to the language and approve. Voting in favor: Broeder, King, Jones, Vortherms, and Wells. Voting against: None. Motion carried.

The Charter Commission discussed Chapters 9-11. There were no comments or requested changes to these chapters.

The Charter Commission also determined that Chapters 12 and 13 will be reviewed at the next meeting. Once a full review of the Le Sueur City Charter is complete, all proposed changes will go to City Council for consideration of adoption.
