

Effective: Monday, November 20, 2023

City staff continually evaluates public safety and traffic flow throughout the City. This evaluation includes study of vehicle traffic, signage, and pedestrian/bicycle safety.

The following traffic control changes were approved by Council on Monday, November 13th and will go into effect on Monday, November 20th. New signage will be flagged.

Intersection of Hazel Street and Peck Street

Hazel street comes to a 'T' intersection at Peck Street and Peck Street serves as a key east-west roadway. The 'Stop' sign on westbound Peck Street will be moved to southbound Hazel Street at this intersection.

Intersection of Park Lane and Central Street

This intersection is currently uncontrolled. Two 'Stop' signs will be placed on Central Street (eastbound and westbound), pausing traffic entering onto and crossing Park Lane.

Intersection of Cantwell Street and South 2nd Street

This intersection is currently uncontrolled. Two 'Stop' signs will be placed on northbound/southbound South Second Street at this intersection.

Intersection of Cantwell Street and South 3rd Street

This intersection is currently uncontrolled. A 'Yield' sign will be placed on eastbound Cantwell Street at this intersection.
